Web site now available for bulk orders of preprinted DHS documents

Previously, customers used a fillable DHS form to order department documents.

Minnesota SeniorCare Plus managed care program goes statewide
As of Jan. 1, all seniors enrolled in Medical Assistance managed care receive their health care through Minnesota SeniorCare Plus (MSC+) health plans. MSC+ includes all Medicaid benefits, as well as Elderly Waiver services and coverage of 180 days of nursing home care. [More information about Minnesota SeniorCare Plus](#) is online.

Health care interpreters wanted for statewide roster
The Minnesota Department of Health is establishing a statewide roster of spoken language interpreters as part of a 2008 legislative initiative addressing concerns about access to health care, particularly in rural areas. The first format for the program lists is the Portable Document Format (PDF).

A PDF file is a file that will look the same on the screen and in print, regardless of what kind of computer or printer someone is using, and regardless of what software package was originally used to create it.

Although PDFs contain the complete formatting of the original document, including fonts and images, PDF files are highly compressed, allowing complex information to be downloaded efficiently. DHS uses the flexibility of PDF to make forms, newsletters, bulletins and other "print" documents readily available online.

Links or documents with the PDF logo  indicate the portable document format. Click on the link or the graphic associated with the PDF file.

Child Foster Care in Excel Format

This list has all the information of the PDF page but it is displayed in Excel format. From the left-hand column, select Comma Separated Values (CSV). The same list will display as on PDF page. Select the county and then click on the CSV link. With this format the worker is able to manipulate the columns to display preferences.

The user must first save the report and rename it in order to make changes.
