

## Notice of Termination of Automatic Withdrawal Program

The Minnesota Department of Human Services is discontinuing the Automatic Withdrawal Program (AWP) for all health care programs. This includes payments for MinnesotaCare, Alternative Care (AC), Medical Assistance for Employed Persons with Disabilities (MA-EPD), medical spenddowns for Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO), and medical spenddowns for Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC).

The last automatic withdrawal will occur on December 10, 2011 for AC, MA-EPD and medical spenddowns for MSHO and SNBC. The last automatic withdrawal for MinnesotaCare premiums will occur on January 10, 2012. Notice to clients about this change was sent with invoices mailed the week of December 5, 2011.

Any unpaid balances or future payments after the AWP ends must be made by personal check, cashier's check, money order or online at <https://payments.dhs.state.mn.us/>.

If payment is made by personal check, cashier's check or money order, please have the client send the payment along with the billing statement to the appropriate program address:
