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## Service Utilization Tables For Children During Calendar Year 2006

In Minnesota, persons may receive public mental health services administered locally by counties and/or through Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP). To qualify as public mental health services, a significant portion, 25 percent or more, of the costs of services are paid through federal, state or county resources.

This report contains information on children age 17 and younger, who received public mental health services in 2006 that were reported to the Community Mental Health Reporting System (CMHRS) and/or provided through MHCP. The data includes the number of children and the hours or days of services they received.

The data on the number of children is shown as "county-administered" clients, those reported to the CMHRS, and additional state clients, children who received services through MHCP that were not county-administered. The inpatient table includes services paid by MHCP; the Regional Treatment Centers (RTCs) table includes services as reported by State-Operated Services (SOS).

In addition to the number of clients, many of the client counts are also reported as *per 10,000 capita*. This is done to allow comparison with other counties which may have similar population demographics but whose size is different. The actual client counts in counties with fewer than 10,000 child residents will be less than the *per 10,000 capita* number.

# Introduction

Historically, the service utilization tables included information reported to the Community Mental Health Reporting System (CMHRS), the Regional Treatment Centers (RTC) information system, and for certain services, data from Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP). Beginning calendar year 2004, all tables include information on MHCP paid claims for mental health services from the Minnesota Medicaid Information System (MMIS). MMIS contains MHCP services paid by:

- Medical Assistance (MA)
- General Assistance Medical Care (GAMC)
- Prepaid Minnesota Health Care Programs (PMHCP)
  - Prepaid Medical Assistance Program (PMAP)
  - Prepaid General Assistance Medical Care Program (PGAMC)
  - Minnesota Disability Health Options (MnDHO)
  - Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO)
- MinnesotaCare
- Other state funded programs.

For many of the service utilization tables, including the MHCP data changed how the client counts are reported. These tables will have the following two columns:

- “County Clients” are those who have been reported to CMHRS as receiving one or more mental health services directly from a county or a provider under contract with a county including all children receiving mental health targeted case management. These clients are considered “county-administered” and will be included in the “County Clients” column for all mental health services that they received.

For example, a client received MHCP paid medication management from a provider who was not under a county contract. In CMHRS, the client was reported as receiving a different service, day treatment, from a contracted provider. The client is considered a county-administered client and is included in the “County Client” column in both the day treatment and medication management tables.

- “Additional State MHCP Clients” are those who had MHCP paid mental health services only. These clients did not receive any services from a county or a provider under contract with a county.
