Why New Security Functions?

- Local agencies requested more security in current SSIS functionality to control visibility of certain information.
- New features in SSIS contain associated security functions.



What Does This Mean?

- Local agencies need review each staff members security functions based on new standards.
- Once V17.3 is installed, agencies can choose to remove certain Functions from any Role that they believe should not have access to these folders.
- Action is required to assign or remove Functions. If this does not occur, the folder in the tree view is hidden from the user.



New SSIS Admin Functions

- **New SSIS Admin security rights accompany new SSIS functionality.**
- **New SSIS Admin security rights accompany current and revised SSIS functionality.**



New SSIS Admin Functions for Tomorrow's Agenda

- In the Child Maltreatment Report presentation, the Manage CP Overrides control access in the new CMR screens.
- In the Mental Health Targeted Case Management Transition to SSIS Outcome Reporting: Employment & Housing presentation, the Access Service Outcomes control's access to the new Housing and Employment Outcome.

How does this work?

- To make it easier for agencies, SSIS defaulted these new Functions into current Roles in order for workers to continue to view the folders without interruption.
- The functions listed on the next slide are available to workers with certain SSIS default Functions.



Which Functions are impacted?

- “View Permanency” Functions controls access to the Permanency folder.
- “View Court Actions” Function controls access to the Court Actions folder.
- “View Disability Diagnosis Sub(stance)” Function controls access to the Disability/Diagnosis/Substance folder.
- “View CMH Screening” Function controls access to the CMH Screenings & Assessments folder.



Which Workers Can View These Folders?

- The following were defaulted into all roles that currently have the following function(s) assigned:
 - *Worker Default Activities and either View Cnty Detail or Access Workgroup, OR*
 - *Fiscal Default Activities and either View Cnty Detail or Access Workgroup, OR*
 - *The combination of Access Person Index and View County Detail.*



Another Defaulted Function

- The following were defaulted into all roles that currently have the following function(s) assigned:
 - *“View Fiscal Details” Function controls access to the Fiscal Details folder under a Person, Case and Business.*



Defaulted Function Related to Revised Child Maltreatment Report

- The following were defaulted into all roles that currently have the following function(s) assigned:
 - *“View Intake Restricted Fields” Function controls accessing/viewing the Source, Caller, and Description of Need fields on any Intake workgroup where they are not currently an assigned primary or secondary worker.*
 - *Being a currently assigned worker gives the user access to these fields whether or not they have the new security function assigned to their role.*
