Release changes for LTCC Claim Category and CMHRS State Report

Due to a policy change/clarification regarding number of days before and after an LTC screening that are eligible to be billed, LTCC will not be part of the upcoming database package release but will be included in Version 5.0 along with MH/TCM. DSD staff will send out a ListServ announcement about the LTCC policy.

Counties should review LTCC claims and submit any claims that are approaching the 12-month service date deadline through MN-ITS. Claims submitted with dates of service more than 12 months old will be denied.

The database package release scheduled for the week of November 7 includes Remittance Advice, DOC point rate changes, and TCM CSR performance enhancement.

The CW/TCM pilot will begin in November, and the CW/TCM claim category is scheduled to be distributed statewide in December. See schedule below for details.

The CMHRS report capability will be included in Version 5.1, scheduled for Spring 2008; updated requirements for the report could not be programmed in time for the 5.0 release. Counties should produce the CMHRS state report for July 1 - December 31, 2007, due February 15, 2008, using CSIS or other county legacy systems. CSIS shut-down dates will be updated the week of December 10, 2007 to allow continued importing of data and submission/transmission of the CMHRS report through February 29, 2008.

Carver, Scott, Olmsted, and Washington are currently piloting the *LTCC package*. Due to a policy change in time periods for claiming LTCC, this claiming category will be turned off when the package is pushed out statewide during the week of November 5.

The CW-TCM pilot will begin soon, piloted by Itasca and Carver Counties.

Scott and Washington Counties will pilot the upcoming Version 5.0. Hennepin County joins the pilot after approximately four weeks.
