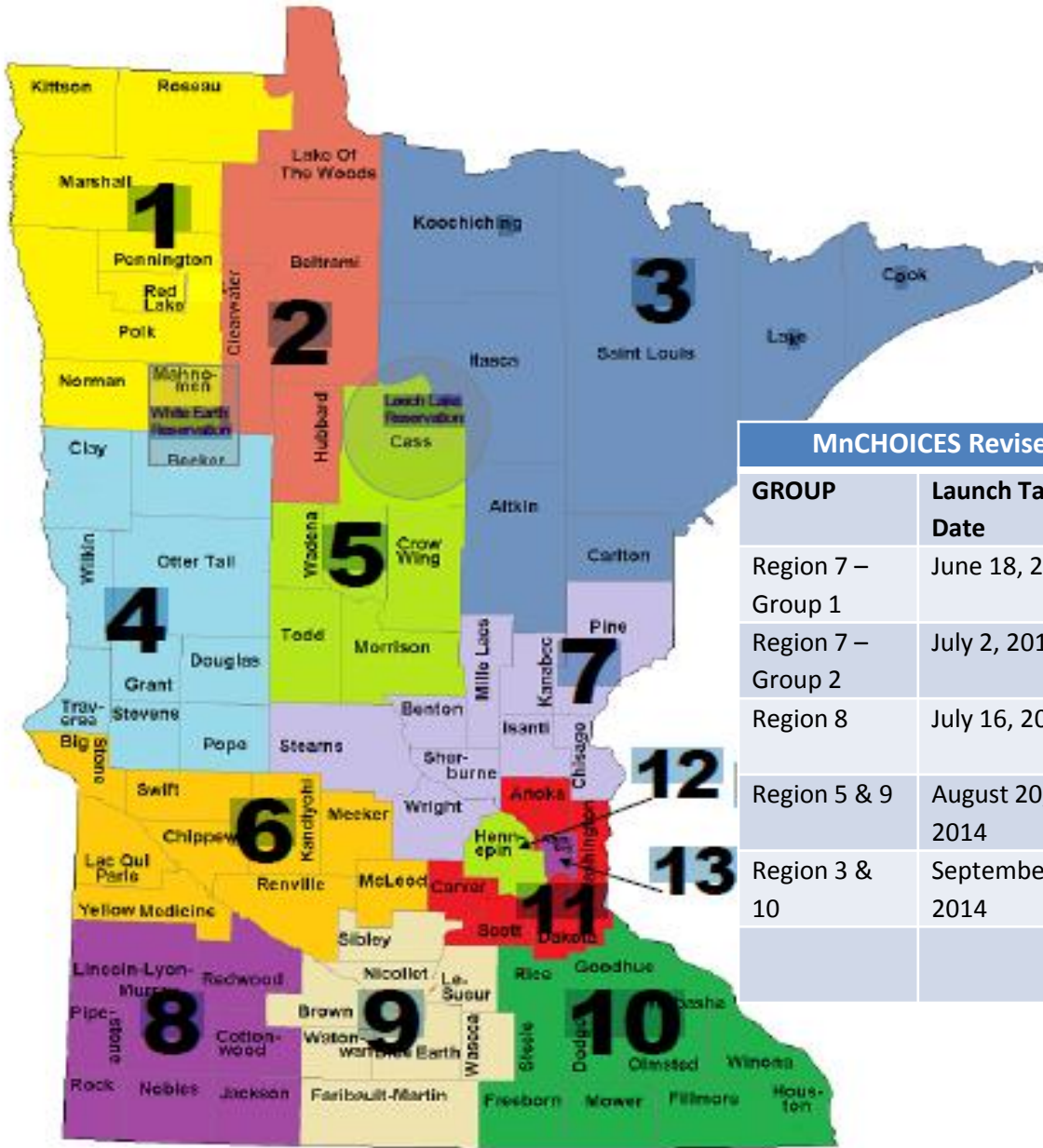

MnCHOICES Q & A

Q: When it comes to MnCHOICES, what is the responsibility of the SSIS Worker Mentor and what should be directed to the MnCHOICES Mentor?

A: The SSIS Admin sets up the MnCHOICES Roles and functions in SSIS. The Admin is also responsible for usernames and password resets.

The MnCHOICES Mentor should assist with any other question related to MnCHOICES.

MnCHOICES Q & A

Q: What information moves over from SSIS to MnCHOICES?

A: Demographic information such as Name, Address, Phone Number, Social Security Number, Date of Birth, Marital Status and Gender. This happens **once** at the **time of intake**. If the person is not cleared to state, the information will not be available to pull into MnCHOICES.

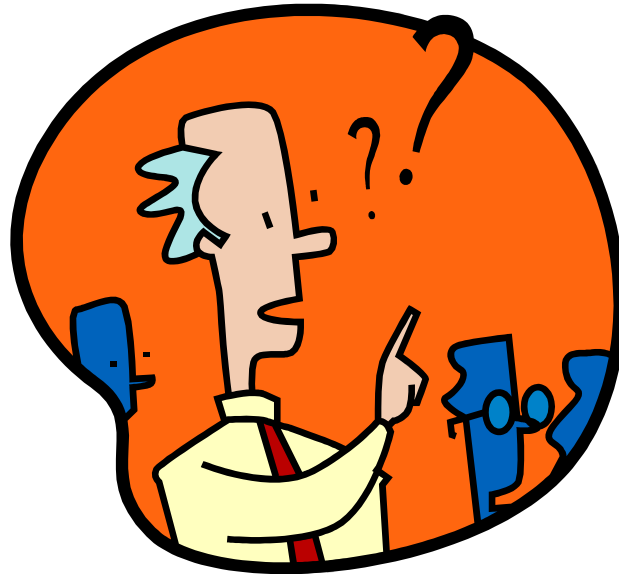
MnCHOICES Q & A
