MAPCY SCORING ADJUSTMENTS

- Refined scoring grids for all children
 - Children 0-6
 - Standard MAPCY levels can get up to Level L without added Child Care or Extraordinary Levels.
 - Previously could only reach Level H
 - Children 7-12
 - Standard MAPCY levels can get up Level L without added Child Care or Extraordinary Levels
 - Previously could only reach Level J
 - Youth 13+, including EFC-SIL
 - Minor change in scoring grid allowing a few more children to reach Level L more easily.

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MAPCY TEXT CHANGES (CONT.)

- Text changes in Domains A, B, C and D
 - D – Child Needs
 - Needs c in Child's Emotional/Behavioral Needs
 - Needs d in Child's Developmental Needs (both Child & Youth)
 - D – Parenting Care and Attention
 - Indicator 17

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MAPCY TEXT CHANGES – CHILD TOOL:

DOMAIN A – PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE

- Parenting Care and Attention - Indicator 8:
 - Previous:
 - Accepts child returning to their home after trial home visit or reunification with parent or relative that included a child experiencing physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect. Child is returning to the same caregiver that previously cared for them.

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD TOOL: DOMAIN A – PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE
(CONT.)**

- Parenting Care and Attention - Indicator 8:
 - Now:
 - Accepts child into their home:
 - *After more than 30 days of hospitalization. Caregiver engaged with child and visited during the hospitalization to develop a relationship and learn about the child's needs,* or
 - After trial home visit or reunification with parent or relative that included a child experiencing physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect. Child is returning to the same caregiver that previously cared for them. (Extensive)

**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
YOUTH TOOL:**

DOMAIN A – PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE

- Parenting Care and Attention - Indicator 9:
 - Previous:
 - Accepts youth returning to their home after trial home visit or reunification with parent or relative that included the youth experiencing physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect. Youth is returning to the same caregiver that previously cared for them.

**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
YOUTH TOOL:
DOMAIN A – PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE (CONT.)**

- Parenting Care and Attention - Indicator 9:
 - New:
 - Accepts youth into their home:
 - *After more than 30 days of hospitalization. Caregiver engaged with youth and visited during the hospitalization to develop a relationship and learn about the youth's needs,* or
 - After trial home visit or reunification with parent or relative that included a youth experiencing physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect. Youth is returning to the same caregiver that previously cared for them.

MAPCY TEXT CHANGES – CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:

DOMAIN B – DYNAMICS IN THE CAREGIVER'S HOME

- Parenting Care and Attention - Indicators 4 (Child) and 5 (Youth):
 - Previous:
 - Identify aggressive interactions in the home that includes physical conflicts among children living in the home that are not typical sibling interactions and adjust parental attention to maintain and teach healthy family interactions.
 - New:
 - Identify interactions in the home that include physical conflicts among children living in the home and makes adjustments to parental attention in order to safely maintain and teach healthy family interactions.

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MAPCY TEXT CHANGES – CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:

DOMAIN B – DYNAMICS IN THE CAREGIVER'S HOME

New Intro for Indicators 11 through 14:

Child receives services that provide the caregiver with relief from parenting duties while family/friends or other professional services care for a child's needs. These parental relief services include respite, personal care attendant (PCA) services, in-home nursing, waived service provider or other designated service provider.

Caregiver:

- Arranges and engages with additional adults or service providers for a child to receive these services, or
- Provides services as a designated waiver service provider or other professional for a period of time in the home.

Child receives services that provide relief from parental care duties for (indicators 11 – 14 remain the same):

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MAPCY TEXT CHANGES – CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:

DOMAIN C – SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE AND STRUCTURE

- Needs c and d – adding *conditions*
 - Child's daily behaviors or *conditions* restrict (prevents) them from participating in age-appropriate activities in the home or community.
 - Child's daily behaviors or *conditions* severely limit their functioning and affect their safety and others' safety.

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:
DOMAIN C – SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE AND
STRUCTURE**

- Parenting Care and Attention – Indicator 8:
 - Previous:
 - Provides individual care and attention for a child who frequently experiences episodes of intense distress that is not typical for their age.

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:
DOMAIN C – SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE AND
STRUCTURE**

- Parenting Care and Attention – Indicator 8:
 - New:
 - Provides individual care and attention for a child who has either:
 - Frequent episodes of intense distress not typical for their age, or
 - *A serious medical condition, illness, disability or complex medical needs.*

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:
DOMAIN D – MENTAL HEALTH, PHYSICAL HEALTH
& DEVELOPMENT**

- D3. Developmental Needs: d
 - Motor, language, cognitive and social/emotional skills are two or more age levels behind chronological age-level expectations. This includes: Gross or fine motor, language, cognitive and social/emotional skills, severe autistic behaviors that are indicative of a severe learning disability. These *major developmental* delays impact a child's ability to perform all, or nearly all, daily living tasks in the home consistent with their age.

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD & YOUTH TOOLS:
DOMAIN D – MENTAL HEALTH, PHYSICAL HEALTH
& DEVELOPMENT**

- Parenting Care and Attention – Indicator 17:
 - Transforms parenting to safely manage child's complex behaviors *or conditions* that are a safety risk to self or others. This requires caregiver to have knowledge about child's medical or mental health needs, adjusts their parenting to meet individual health needs, and utilize community medical and mental health services to safely care for child in the home.

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**MAPCY TEXT CHANGES –
CHILD TOOL:
DOMAIN F – DEVELOPING IDENTITY**

- Child tool now allows assessors to select parenting indicators for children age 3 and under
 - New:
 - Note: If child is not yet 3 years old, child's needs should be rated "b." Parental Care and Attention is measured in this domain, regardless of child's age.

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NEW MAPCY DOCUMENTS

- MAPCY Assessment Notice – Caregiver FC to Permanency (RTF header required)
- Extraordinary Level Approval Notice – Foster Care to Permanency (No header required)

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WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

- MAPCYs created prior to V15.4 that are in draft/pending agency approval cannot be edited or approved:
 - "Copy MAPCY", reset to draft and then delete the old version of the MAPCY
 - Extraordinary Levels needs to be re-entered for any new MAPCYs
 - Previously approved MAPCY's can be reassessed or revised by using:
 - "Copy MAPCY" (changes the effective date), or
 - "Create Revised MAPCY" (keeps the same effective date)

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MAPCY SETUP SCREEN – CHANGES COMING SOON IN 16.1 STAY TUNED!

- Purpose:
 - "Foster Care Benefit Level" must be the purpose in the Setup Screen for the initial MAPCY
 - New business rule will be implemented
 - Result in error message
