

APS SDM Tools updates for SSIS v16.3

SSIS v16.2 introduced two Adult Protective Services SDM tools. These two tools are:

1. Adult Protection Intake Assessment and Response Priority
2. Adult Protection Initial Safety Assessment

The following are the SSIS v16.3 updates relate to these tools.

1.1 New Policy Override Option

A new Policy override option was been added to the Adult Protection Intake Assessment and Response Priority tool. This option is "Screened out EPS. County not LIA".

1.2 New Data Cleanup Rules

1.2.1 Adult Protection Intake Assessment and Response Priority Tool

An Intake workgroup data cleanup rule, where program is Adult Protective Services, will require an Adult Protection Intake Assessment and Response Priority SDM tool with a status of either "Complete", "Complete-override approved" or "Pending override approval" in order to close the Intake, unless a bounced Adult Maltreatment Report exist.



1.2.2 Adult Protection Initial Safety Assessment Tool

An Assessment workgroup data cleanup rule, where program is Adult Protective Services, will require an Initial Safety Assessment SDM tool with a status of "Complete" in order to close the Intake, unless all allegations of the associated Adult Maltreatment Report are determined as "No determination – investigation not possible" or "No determination – not a vulnerable adult".
