### **CORRECTION ORDER**

Dear Julie Landru

On March 10, 2025, a licensing review of Resurrection Ranch, located at 8752 Viking Boulevard Northwest, Elk River, Minnesota, was conducted to determine compliance with state and federal laws and rules governing the provision of home and community-based services to persons with disabilities and age 65 and older under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 245D. As a result of this licensing review a Correction Order is being issued.

#### **A. Reason for Correction Order**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06, if the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services (DHS) finds that the license holder has failed to comply with an applicable law or rule and this failure does not imminently endanger the health, safety, or rights of the persons served by the program, the Commissioner may issue a Correction Order to the license holder.

The following violation(s) of state or federal laws and rules were determined as a result of the licensing review. Corrective action for each violation is required by Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06 and is hereby ordered by the Commissioner of Human Services.

1. Citation: Minnesota Statutes, section 245D.071, subdivision 3, paragraph (b).

Violation: For one of one person whose record was reviewed (P1), the license holder did not conduct annual assessments as required.

The license holder failed to complete accurate assessments for P1 in the following areas:

- the person's ability to self-manage health and medical needs to maintain or improve physical, mental, and emotional well-being, including, when applicable, allergies, seizures, choking, special dietary needs, chronic medical conditions, self-administration of medication or treatment orders, preventative screening, and medical and dental appointments;
- the person's ability to self-manage personal safety to avoid injury or accident in the service setting, including, when applicable, risk of falling, mobility, regulating water temperature, community survival skills, water safety skills, and sensory disabilities; and
- the person's ability to self-manage symptoms or behavior that may otherwise result in an incident as defined in section 245D.02, subdivision 11, clauses (4) to (7), suspension or termination of services by the license holder, or other symptoms or behaviors that may jeopardize the health and welfare of the person or others.

Corrective Action Ordered: Within 30 days of receiving this order, you must:

- complete assessments in the above-mentioned areas based on P1's status within the previous 12 months;
- these assessments must produce information about P1 that describes their overall strengths, functional skills and abilities, and behaviors or symptoms; and
- review the results of these assessments with P1 and P1's case manager. You must document the review in P1's service recipient record.

On an ongoing basis, you must maintain compliance as required in this subdivision.

2. Citation: Minnesota Statutes, section 245D.095, subdivision 3, paragraph (b), clause (11).

Violation: For one person whose record was reviewed (P1), the license holder did not maintain progress or daily notes as required.

The license holder failed to maintain progress or daily log notes that are recorded by the program in P1's service recipient record for each day the license holder provided services to P1.

Corrective Action Ordered: Immediately upon receipt of this order, you must begin maintaining progress or daily log notes for P1 in P1's service recipient record. On an ongoing basis, you must maintain compliance as required in this subdivision.

If you fail to correct the violations specified in the Correction Order within the prescribed time lines the Commissioner may issue an Order of Conditional License or may impose a fine and order other licensing sanctions pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, sections 245A.06 and 245A.07.

## **B. Right to Request Reconsideration**

If you believe any of the citations are in error, you have the right to request that the Commissioner of Human Services reconsider the parts of the Correction Order that you believe to be in error. The request for reconsideration must be in writing and received by the Commissioner within 20 calendar days after receipt of this report. Your request for reconsideration must be sent to:
