### **CFSS implementation updates**

DHS began the transition from PCA and CSG to CFSS on Oct. 1, 2024. We will provide regular updates throughout the transition.

#### **Policy manual**

DHS made the following changes:

- Posted [CFSS Manual – PCA/CFSS services on a waiver/Alternative Care](#).
- Updated [CFSS Manual – PCA/CFSS covered personal care services](#) and [CFSS Manual – PCA/CFSS service delivery plan](#) to clarify what people must include on their CFSS service delivery plan. DHS no longer requires a person to include instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs) listed in their assessment results unless a paid worker will provide support for that IADL.
