CORRECTION ORDER

Dear Alicia Carey:

On May 15, 2025, a licensing investigation of Olu's Home Inc located at 1315 12th Avenue North, Minneapolis, Minnesota, was conducted to determine compliance with state and federal laws and rules governing the provision of home and community-based services to persons with disabilities and age 65 and older under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 245D. As a result of this licensing complaint investigation a Correction Order is being issued.

A. Reason for Correction Order

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06, if the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services (DHS) finds that the license holder has failed to comply with an applicable law or rule and this failure does not imminently endanger the health, safety, or rights of the persons served by the program, the Commissioner may issue a Correction Order to the license holder.

The following violation(s) of state or federal laws and rules were determined as a result of the licensing complaint investigation. Corrective action for each violation is required by Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06 and is hereby ordered by the Commissioner of Human Services.

1. Citation: Minnesota Statute, section 245D.07, subdivision 1a.

Violation: For one of one person whose record was reviewed (P1), the license holder did not ensure person centered service delivery as required.

P1's support plan addendum stated that P1 has no alone time while at home or in the community. The license holder failed to provide services in response to P1's identified needs as specified in P1's support plan addendum when a staff person left P1 home unsupervised on March 22, 2025, which resulted in a call to 911 made by P1.

Corrective Action Ordered: Immediately upon receiving this order and ongoing, you must ensure that P1 receives services in response to P1's identified needs as specified in P1's support plan and support plan addendum. On an ongoing basis, you must maintain compliance throughout your program, as required in this subdivision.

If you fail to correct the violations specified in the Correction Order within the prescribed time lines the Commissioner may issue an Order of Conditional License or may impose a fine and order other licensing sanctions pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, sections 245A.06 and 245A.07.

B. Right to Request Reconsideration

If you believe any of the citations are in error, you have the right to request that the Commissioner of Human Services reconsider the parts of the Correction Order that you believe to be in error. The request for reconsideration must be in writing and received by the Commissioner within 20 calendar days after receipt of this report. Your request for reconsideration must be sent to:

Please note that a request for reconsideration does not stay any provisions or requirements of the Correction Order. The Commissioner's disposition of a request for reconsideration is final and not subject to appeal under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14.
