Changes to informed consent procedure for Moving Home Minnesota

DHS no longer requires that it receives a completed informed consent form before a person uses the [Moving Home Minnesota \(MHM\)](#) benefit. However, lead agency and other transition coordinators are still required to provide informed consent prior to a person's participation in the program. The MHM provider must keep a copy of the consent form in the person's file.

Background

Everyone who receives MHM services is required to get the information they need to make informed choices regarding their living situation and the services they receive. This extends to a person's family members, guardians and other legal representatives that help the person make decisions about their medical care and support. This is the same consent procedure used for other home and community-based services (HCBS).
