All clear to enter and change service agreements in MMIS

DHS completed the rate changes and the automation process in MMIS. Lead agency staff can resume entering or making changes to service agreements for:

- Alternative Care (AC).
- Brain Injury (BI) Waiver.
- Community Alternative Care (CAC) Waiver.
- Community Access for Disability Inclusion (CADI) Waiver.
- Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver.
- Elderly Waiver (EW).
- Essential Community Supports (ECS).
- Community First Services and Supports (CFSS).
- Consumer Support Grant (CSG).

To identify affected service agreements, use the following Infopac reports:

- MW2083A: Procedure Code Rate Increase Report LTC Waivers/AC Program.
- MW2083B: Procedure Code Rate Increase DD Program.
- MW2083D: Procedure Code Rate Increase CSG.
- MW2083H: Procedure Code Rate Change ECS Program.
