CFSS information sessions

DHS and Crow Wing County will host two in-person CFSS information sessions for people who receive services. Each session will include:

- Basic information about CFSS (e.g., how to choose a CFSS service model, how to develop a service delivery plan).
- Time for people to ask DHS personnel questions.
- Opportunities for people to connect directly with consultation service providers.
