CORRECTION ORDER

Dear Abdullahi Hussein:

On December 1, 2025, a licensing review of Mercy Adult Daycare Center LLC located at 912 East 24th Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, was conducted to determine compliance with Minnesota Statutes and Rules governing adult day care services under Minnesota Rules, parts 9555.9600 through 9555.9730 (Rule 223). As a result of this licensing review, a Correction Order is being issued.

A. Reason for Correction Order

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06, if the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services (DHS) finds that the license holder has failed to comply with an applicable law or rule and this failure does not imminently endanger the health, safety, or rights of the persons served by the program, the Commissioner may issue a Correction Order to the license holder.

The following violation(s) of state or federal laws and rules were determined as a result of the licensing review. Corrective action for each violation is required by Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.06 and is hereby ordered by the Commissioner of Human Services.

1. Citation: Minnesota Rules, part 9555.9720, subparts 7, 8, and 9.

Violation: The license holder did not ensure safety as required.

- a. The license holder did not ensure equipment and furniture was in good repair including:
 - missing floorboards by exit door on west side; and
 - several missing ceiling tiles.
- b. The license holder did not ensure areas used by persons receiving services were free from loose plaster and peeling paint.
- c. The license holder did not ensure the emergency plans included:
 - identification of primary and secondary exits; and

- identification of building evacuation routes.

Repeat Violation: In a Correction Order that DHS issued on February 4, 2025, you were previously found in violation of this same rule.

Corrective Action Ordered: Within 30 days of receiving this order, you must:

- ensure equipment and furniture are in good repair that includes the areas detailed above;
- ensure areas used by participants are free from loose plaster and peeling paint; and
- update the floor and emergency plans to include the identification of primary and secondary exits and building evacuation routes that include the added space.

On an ongoing basis, you must maintain compliance as required in these subparts.

2. Citation: Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.04, subdivision 7a, paragraph (b).

Violation: The license holder did not notify the commissioner, in a manner prescribed by the commissioner, before making any change as required.

The license holder did not notify the commissioner, in a manner prescribed by the commissioner, before making any change in the location of adult day care services licensed under this chapter. At the time of the licensing review, licensors observed the license holder providing adult day care services in a space that was not licensed by DHS.

Corrective Action Ordered: Immediately, you must provide adult day care services in the space that is licensed by DHS. On an ongoing basis, you must maintain compliance as required in this subdivision.

If you fail to correct the violations specified in the Correction Order within the prescribed time lines the Commissioner may issue an Order of Conditional License or may impose a fine and order other licensing sanctions pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, sections 245A.06 and 245A.07.

B. Right to Request Reconsideration

If you believe any of the citations are in error, you have the right to request that the Commissioner of Human Services reconsider the parts of the Correction Order that you believe to be in error. The request for reconsideration must be in writing and received by the Commissioner within 20 calendar days after receipt of this report. Your request for reconsideration must be sent to:
