Bus Org./Provider	(Design Change) Data Clean-Up: Per request from policy staff, a new data clean-up message displays for active Business Organizations identified as child placement providers (by valuing "Foster Family Setting" on the "Foster Care/Day Care Provider" tab) to require a current "Physical Location Address" type address with a valid "County" selected.
Bus Org./Provider	(Design Change) Data Clean-Up: Per request from policy staff, a new data clean-up message displays for a Bus Org./Provider on an open "Placement" or "Location" requiring a current "Physical Location" type address with a valid "County" selected.
Child Maltreatment	Child Maltreatment Report tabs: The "Save" and "Cancel" buttons, including the menu options, are correctly disabled after clicking "Save" (screen in view mode) for the following tabs: 1. "Allegations" 2. "Initial Notifications" 3. "Facility Information" 4. "Victim Information"
Child Maltreatment	Time to Initial Contact with Victim(s) general report: The "Worker" column is correctly displaying the "Primary Worker" on the associated workgroup assigned as of the Child Maltreatment Report "End Date" (if valued).

The data from that screen is now copied when Copy Clients is used.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. When the Disrupted (non-finalized) Adoptions group box, if the question "Is this placement a result of a disrupted (non-finalized) foreign adoption?" is Yes, the answer to what agency placed the child for adoption? is copied. 2. Reason(s) for disruption and the Current plans for the child fields cannot be copied. 3. Create Date is the date the copy is made. 4. Last Reviewed Date is blank.
Exp. Statewide Search	<p>Copy Clients: Client demographics can now be copied from one agency to another. The error message "Cannot copy from a county at a previous SSIS release level." no longer displays that previously prevented copying.</p>
Intake	<p>Intake/Workgroup: Per request from policy staff, the label is displayed as "Agency WG #" on the following screens:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Intake "Workgroup" tab. 2. Workgroup panel 3. "Intake Maltreatment Report Searches > Adult Maltreatment Main Search" (search criteria section) 4. "Intake Maltreatment Report Searches > Child Maltreatment Main Search" (search criteria section) 5. "Workgroup Maltreatment Report Searches > Child Maltreatment Main Search" (search criteria section) 6. "Workgroup Maltreatment Report Searches > Adult Maltreatment Main Search" (search criteria section)
Lookup-Address/Phone/Email	<p>Person and Business Organization Address: The "County" dropdown on the address entry form is correctly displaying only the 87 Minnesota Counties, "Out of State", and "Out of U.S." An existing address with a different value will continue to display that selection until changed.</p>
Northstar Fiscal Reconciliation	<p>PDF Viewer: The following screens now display "PDF Exists" with a button "View PDF" that, when clicked, opens the form in an external PDF viewer or internet browser:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Northstar Care for Children Fiscal Reconciliation > Agency Output tab 2. Chronology Legacy Documents and Reports 3. Legacy Service Plans 4. Legacy Submissions to DHS Adoptions Unit Document 5. SAE Status Verifications > Report and Document tabs 6. Child SDM Blank Tools/Definitions as accessed via Workgroup > Decision Tools
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	<p>Person: The "Clearing Status" field no longer displays a red required field marker on a "New Collateral" when the field is valued and disabled.</p>
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	<p>SEY/STY: The help text links for the "SEY/STY" screen are available in "Help" and by clicking the field hyperlinks.</p>
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	<p>Relationship: Reestablished Parent/Child relationships display with a Status of Reestablished and a Reestablished Date after DHS guardianship is dismissed. Data fixes to update the Relationship data are no longer necessary after DHS guardianship has been dismissed.</p>

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Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	(Design Change) Data Clean-up: Per request from policy staff, a new data clean-up message displays for a child in an open Placement or Location requiring the associated Bus Org/Provider have a "Physical Location" type address with a valid "County" selected.
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	The new Pregnant/Parenting Node under the Person is ready for use. There are 3 data clean-up messages associated with this new node, Two of them, PP01 & PP02 are not being released for 20.3 but will come in release 20.4. Data clean-up PP03 was ready and will be usable right away with the new node.
Programs and Services	HCPCS/Modifiers: For "T2023 HA HE "MH-TCM child, face-to-face", for Service: 490 - Child Rule 79 Case Management the "Collateral contact", is now removed as a Claimable Activity. On further review, "Collateral contact" is not a Claimable Activity for that HCPCS/Modifier.
Reports architecture	General Reports > Data Integrity Reports: Per request from policy staff, the "Clients Age 12 and Under as Offenders in Intakes or Workgroups Where the Victim is Age 18 or Younger" report no longer displays. The age (12) does not match current guidelines (10) and there is another report under General Reports > Child Maltreatment that covers the Determined Offenders: "Clients Age 10 and under as Determined Offenders."
Service Plan & Review	(Design Change) Minor Parent Assessment and Service Plan: Per request from policy staff, the "Minor Parent Assessment and Service Plan" replaces the "Adolescent Parent Assessment and Service Plan". The External Documents link is updated with the new blank service plan. Existing "Adolescent Parent Assessment and Service Plan" service plans can be copied to the new service plan.
Vulnerable Adult	Intake: Per request from policy staff, the Intake "Start Date/Time" and "Workgroup" tab field "Start Date/Time" are disabled for editing when the intake originates in MAARC Call Center (e.g. "Intake Type" is "Adult maltreatment report").
Vulnerable Adult	Adult Maltreatment Report > Allegations tab: Per request from policy staff, the dropdown description for the following question displays "Yes, Department of Health" replacing previous description: "Was the alleged perpetrator providing services licensed by the Minnesota Department of Human Services or Department of Health at the time of the alleged maltreatment?"
Vulnerable Adult	(Design Change) Adult Maltreatment Report: Per request from policy staff, a new field labelled "MAARC Received Date" displays on the "Adult Maltreatment Report" tab with date and time information when the MAARC Call Center received the report. The field, along with a "County Received Date" field, are now displaying on the printed report. The "MAARC Received Date" on both the screen and printed report display blank for any existing Adult Maltreatment Reports.
Vulnerable Adult	(Design Change) Transfer: Per request from policy staff, the "Transfer Log" now includes a menu option for "View Call Center Report" that opens a PDF document of the originally received MAARC Call Center maltreatment report. The PDF document is also accessible via a new "Adult Maltreatment Report" treeview node labelled "Transfer" and the menu option "View Call Center Report". The PDF document is only available for Adult Maltreatment Reports received after MAARC Call Center received version 20.3.
Workgroup & Related/Caseload List	Case List - with Clients report (banded style): At the end of the report, the Total counts display based on the Program (s) selected instead as if all Programs were selected on the Setup tab.
