

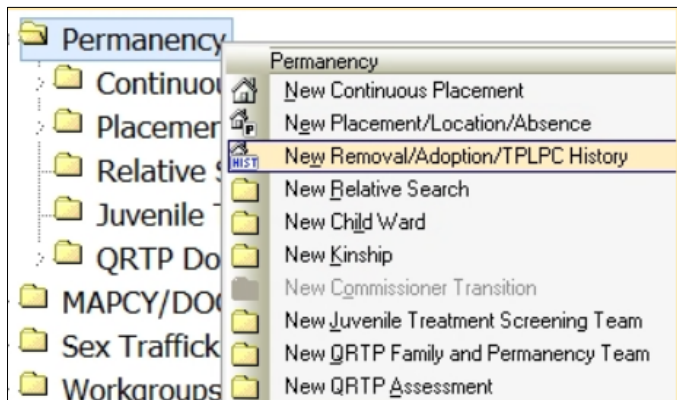
Removal/Adoption/TPLPC History

The **Removal/Adoption/TPLPC History** screen is designed to obtain current data in each field. Users can edit this full screen at any time to make changes. A **Removal/Adoption/TPLPC History** record must exist if a child has a current open continuous placement episode.

Only one record/screen can exist for a person at any given time. During a current open continuous placement episode, certain questions must be answered. If left blank, users will not be able to save information on this screen and an error message will display. A data cleanup error will display if this screen is not completed. Previous case workers may have recorded information on this screen already, so it is important for current caseworker to be sure to review and update as needed.

Required questions to be answered in each section include:

- Was the child adopted prior to the current continuous placement? (Adoption history section).
- Is this placement a result of a disrupted (non-finalized) foreign adoption? (Disrupted non-finalized Adoptions section).
- Was there a TPLPC/transfer of custody order through juvenile/family court for this child prior to the current continuous placement? (TPLPC/Legal Guardian History section).
- Last reviewed date.

Removal History

Complete this section to document a known removal date that is earlier than the first removal recorded by agency staff:

- **Date of first removal recorded in this agency** is a display only field and not editable on this screen. The start date displays, which is the earliest continuous placement recorded by agency.

An earlier removal date, if known, can be a date known from another county or state. The previous removal date must be prior to the earliest continuous placement date in the county (as documented in the first question). If unknown, leave this field blank.

Adoption History

This section helps identify whether a child was legally adopted prior to their current out-of-home placement episode. All types of legal adoptions are considered in this question, including public (county or tribal), or private agency, including tribal customary adoptions that finalized in the U.S. or in another country. See the blue help text associated with this section for examples.

- Workers use the dropdown list options to answer the question **Was the child adopted prior to the current continuous placement episode?** Options in the dropdown list for this question include **Yes/No/Abandoned**.
- If the answer is **Yes**, the remaining questions in this section must be answered:
 - Workers enter the **Date of the most recent finalized adoption prior to the current continuous placement** using the date picker or manually in this field. This date must be on or prior to the current continuous placement episode start date.
 - The **Age at most recent finalized adoption** is a legacy field and no longer applicable, but displays the date entered in previous versions of SSIS.
 - The **Most recent finalized adoption was from** field includes a dropdown list of choices that include **Within Minnesota, Another State/U.S. Territory, and Another Country**.
- If the answer is **No**, proceed to the next section.
- If the answer is **Abandoned**, it means that child was left alone or with others and the identity of parent/s or legal guardian/s is unknown and cannot be ascertained. This includes a child left at Safe Place for Newborns. Proceed to the next section.

Disrupted (non-finalized) Adoption

This is a required section. Answer questions in this section regarding any known disrupted (non-finalized) foreign adoptions, referring to an intercountry adoption in which a child from another country is brought to the U.S. for purposes of adoption:

- Answer the required question **Is this placement a result of a disrupted (non-finalized) foreign adoption?** **Yes** and **No** option buttons for answering this question.
- If the answer is **Yes** to this question, the remainder of questions in this section are required to be answered, enter:
 - Agency name in the field marked **If yes, what agency placed the child for adoption?**
 - Reason for disruption in the **Reason for disruption** field.
 - Current plans for child in the **Current plans for the child** field.
- If the answer is **No** proceed to next section.

Transfer of Permanent Legal and Physical Custody (TPLPC)/Legal Guardian History

This section is required, capturing data regarding child's past experience/s with TPLPC or transfer of custody order, whether through family court or juvenile protection proceedings, prior to entering out-of-home placement. See blue help text for information and examples:

- Using the dropdown list, workers answer the question **Was there a TPLPC/transfer of custody order through juvenile/family court for this child prior to the current placement?** The dropdown selections are **Yes/No/Abandoned**.
- If answering the first question in this section **Yes, Date of the most recent TPLPC/transfer of custody order through juvenile/family court for this child (prior to this continuous placement)**, must be answered with a date entered.
- If selecting **No** or **Abandoned**, the section is complete; proceed to the next section.

Last Reviewed Date and Create Date

The **Last Reviewed Date (date this screen was last reviewed for accuracy)** field is where workers enter date this screen was last viewed for accuracy.

This screen must be reviewed for accuracy at least once per continuous placement episode. Upon saving changes in this screen a warning message appears to indicate if the last reviewed date was not updated. This reminds workers to record the last review date.

The Create Date field auto-fills with the date that a record was created; this field cannot be modified, it is for display only.
